The journey of Ankur School began in the late 1950s, when a small but dedicated group of the spouses of the Panjab University (PU) faculty came together with a vision to uplift the educational standards of the children of university employees, particularly those belonging to the working-class families. This informal group, later known as the Students' Aid Society, embarked on a mission to provide quality education to the children of labourers and class IV employees of the University. Their efforts began with raising modest monthly donations, sometimes as little as a rupee or even a few paise, to fund this noble cause.

The idea of establishing a formal educational institution on the university campus was an aspiration cherished by the residents of the University. After several discussions, the Society took the bold step to turn this vision into reality, with a focus on providing early childhood education. The result was the establishment of **Ankur Nursery School**.

In 1973, the foundation stone for the school was laid by **Smt. Parkashwati Pathak**, wife of the then Vice-President of India and Chancellor of Panjab University, on **February 25th**. The school building was completed in 1976 and its inauguration took place in March of the same year, with **Mrs. Sangamma Jatti**, wife of the Vice-President of India and Chancellor of Panjab University, presiding over the ceremony.









From its humble beginnings, Ankur Nursery School gradually flourished into one of the most reputed institutions in Chandigarh. With dedication and hard work from the Management, Principals, teachers, and staff, the school expanded its curriculum and facilities over the years. What began as a small nursery school eventually grew into a full-fledged educational institution.

In the years that followed, Ankur School was upgraded to a **Primary**, **Middle**, and **Senior Secondary School**, offering a comprehensive education in all three streams: **Science**, **Commerce** and **Humanities**.

The school reached significant milestones with the **first batch of Class X students** graduating in 2013 and the **first batch of Senior Secondary students** passing out in 2019, marking a new chapter in the institution's legacy.

Today, Ankur School stands as a symbol of dedication, commitment, and excellence in education, continuing its mission of empowering children from all walks of life and providing them with the foundation to achieve success and contribute meaningfully to society.

The goals of Ankur School are-

- 1. To initiate or undertake any scheme for the welfare of the students.
- 2. To collect funds through donations, subscriptions, film shows in the university campus, dramas and organizing fetes etc, for providing aid to needy students.

- 2. No change of subject is allowed in Class XII (allowed only in special cases)

- 4. Students opting Computer Science cannot opt I.T or Typography.
- 5. Total number of seats available are 40 each (Commerce, Humanities, Medical and Non-Medical)



LEAVE AND RE-ADMISSION

- (1) Leave must be applied on a printed application form attached in the school diary as supplied by the school. In case of sickness and post dated sanction, certificate from a qualified doctor is compulsory.
- (2) Name of the student will be struck off the rolls of the school in case there is an unexplained, continuous absence for 10 days or leave having not obtained in advance. Genuine cases will always be considered with compassion.
- (3) In case of re-admission he/she can be re-admitted by paying re-admission fee.
- (4) Short leave for one hour allowed only in case of an emergency.
- (5) Half day leave allowed only in case of sickness and not otherwise.

- (f) TC from the previous school for admission to classes L.K.G. onwards.
- (g) Latest salary slip with PF Number (For Panjab University Employees)

A) ADMISSION TO NURSERY (ENTRANT CLASS)

- (a) The admission will be given on the basis of draw as per orders of the District Education Office of U.T. Chandigarh.
- (b) Seats have been reserved for
- (1) EWS (25%): as per the order of the DEO.
- (2) The wards of Panjab University employees.

B) ADMISSION FROM CLASSES L.K.G TO IX

Admission to these classes depends on the availability of seats.

C) ADMISSION TO CLASS XI (COMMERCE/HUMANITIES

AND SCIENCE -MEDICAL/NON-MEDICAL)I. Before declaration of CBSE result ,provisional admission is given on the basis of Pre-Board result.

RULES OF WITHDRAWAL

- 1. A student who wishes to leave the school must apply in writing to the Principal.
- 2. The application must be countersigned by the parents.
- 3. A month's notice or one month's fee in lieu has to be paid when a student is to be withdrawn.
- 4. Those who leave the school in month of May must in all cases pay the fee for the existing quarter.
- 5. School leaving certificate will be issued only after the student has cleared all the dues.




